Intro: *Luke 14:18-20niv* reads as follows: **18** *“But they all alike began to make excuses. The first said, ‘I have just bought a field, and I must go and see it. Please excuse me.’ 19 “Another said, ‘I have just bought five yoke of oxen, and I’m on my way to try them out. Please excuse me.’ 20 “Still another said, ‘I just got married, so I can’t come.’* These verses record part of a parable Jesus used to show us how people often use excuses to justify their failure to make God their top priority. Because people often prioritize their own desires over the desires of God, many of them have failed to start, work on, or complete that which God has called them to do.

Lesson Focus: This lesson is designed to show us that, in spite of our excuses, God is fully able to help us do what He has called us to do.
