Intro: Psalm 105:1-2niv reads, v1 Give praise to the LORD, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done.v2Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts. There are times in our life when reflecting on all that God has done for us brings to mind the words of a song that speaks to the exact thing God has done. In some instances, the song effectively communicates what we are actually feeling at that particular moment about God. Songs like, If It Had Not Been For The Lord, Amazing Grace, Never Would Have Made It, and I Know It Was The Blood are all examples of songs that often record exactly what God has done and/or what we feel. As David reflected on all that God had done, he penned the words of 2 Samuel 22.
