Intro: *Psalm 105:1-2niv* reads, **v1** Give praise to the LORD, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done. **v2** Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts. There are times in our life when reflecting on all that God has done for us brings to mind the words of a song that speaks to the exact thing God has done. In some instances, the song effectively communicates what we are actually feeling at that particular moment about God.
