

Sermon Notes: "A Blessing Behind Closed Doors"

Text: 2 Kings 4:1-7 (NIV)

Introduction: The Crisis

I. GOD MEETS YOU AT THE POINT OF YOUR NEED (vv.1–2)

“What do you have in your house?”

II. OBEDIENT FAITH PREPARES THE WAY FOR GOD’S PROVISION (vv.3–4)

“Borrow vessels... not a few.”

III. GOD MULTIPLIES WHAT WE SURRENDER TO HIM (vv.5–6)

“And the oil stopped only when the vessels were full.”

IV. GOD’S PROVISION REDEEMS, RESTORES, AND SUSTAINS (v.7)

“Pay your debt... and live on the rest.”
