Title:

Text: **Genesis 22-24esv**

Objective: By the end of this lesson, participants will understand what characterized Enoch's walk with God and identify practical ways to stay close to God, trust God completely, and stand boldly for God.

Talk It Out

1. What are some common distractions that can cause believers to drift away from God?

2. Why is it sometimes difficult to trust God when we do not understand what He is doing?

3. How does spending time with God strengthen our faith and relationship with Him?

4. What does it look like to stand boldly for God in today's culture without becoming harsh or unloving?

Life Application: Encourage participants to reflect: Have I been staying close to God through prayer and Scripture? Am I trusting God in an area where I do not have all the answers? Is my life influencing others toward God or simply reflecting the culture around me?

Challenge: This week, identify one area where you need to walk more closely with God. Spend intentional time in prayer and Scripture each day, asking God to increase your faith and give you courage to stand for Him.

Memory Verse: **Genesis 5:24esv** – Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him.
